First global summit on Traditional Medicine was organised by the World Health Organization (WHO) and co-hosted by the Ministry of Ayush, 2023, at Gandhinagar, Gujarat.

'Gujarat Declaration' underlining outcome of the first WHO Traditional Medicine Global Summit 2023

Objective of Gujarat declaration

- 'Gujarat Declaration' reaffirms global commitment and harness potential of traditional medicine to achieve health and well-being for all
- India as host of WHO-GCTM will scale up WHO's capacities to support member states and take forward the summit action agenda
- WHO underlined that the application of rigorous scientific methods is needed to better understand, assess and, where appropriate, apply more holistic, context-specific, complex and personalized approaches for health and well-being for all.
- Gujarat declaration is testimony of our prime minister's commitment to promote our ancient knowledge of Traditional Medicine system.
- Gujarat declaration talks about scaling up efforts to further implement evidence-based TCIM (Traditional complimentary integrative medicine) interventions and approaches in support of the goal of universal health coverage (UHC) and all health-related Sustainable

Development Goals (SDGs)

 It facilitate to recognize, respect and protect the rights of Indigenous Peoples, as provided in the UN Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples. Incorporate ethical methods and processes in TCIM research and practice.

From Mona Lisa to Panini Ashtadhyayi, list of 29 countries heritages that will be showcased at venue

Some Important Heritages

- Panini Ashtadhyayi: This linguistic text that set the standard for Sanskrit was meant to be written and spoken will be represented by India.
- Mona Lisa: The iconic painting by Leonardo da Vinci will also be shown at the G2O Summit.
- Magna Carta: UK's Magna Carta is a royal charter of rights agreed to by King John of England at Windsor on 15 June 1215.
- Gutenberg Bible: This is the earliest book printed in Germany
- Coatlicue statue: It is an Aztec sculpture from Mexico.
- Abrahamic Family House: It is an interfaith complex in Abu
 Dhabi, UAE
- Kosode: A short-sleeved garment, the direct predecessor of the Kimono from Japan.

About Ashtadhyayi

- The Ashtadhyayi laid down more than 4,000 grammatical rules.
- Later Indian grammars such as the Mahabhasya of Patanjali (2nd century BC) and the Kasika
 Vritti of Jayaditya and Vamana (7th century AD), were mostly commentaries on Panini.
- Ashtadhyayi (8 chapters) was written by the scholar Panini towards the end of the fourth century BC.
